

Announcement of the Appointment of H.E. Moussa Faki as Special Envoy for the Pact for Prosperity, People and the Planet (4P)



The 4P is pleased to announce the appointment of H.E. Moussa Faki as the Special Envoy for the Pact for Prosperity, People and the Planet (4P).

H.E. Moussa Faki Mahamat is a prominent Chadian diplomat

and statesman, who brings to this role a vast experience in governance and multilateral diplomacy. He served as Prime Minister of Chad (2003–2005) and Minister of Foreign Affairs (2008–2017), playing a central role in Chad’s membership on the United Nations Security Council and advancing diplomatic efforts in Libya, Sudan, and Mali. He is fluent in French, Arabic, and English.

From 2017 to 2025, he served two terms as Chairperson of the African Union Commission, where he led key continental initiatives including the African Continental Free Trade Area, sovereign African strategies on nutrition and healthcare, development financing, environmental action, and peace negotiations in Sudan, South Sudan, and the Central African Republic.

His leadership has consistently championed peace, inclusive development, and multilateral cooperation, with a focus on the most vulnerable populations. Notable achievements include African-led security solutions and the establishment of regional organizations such as the G5 Sahel and the Multinational Joint Task Force (MNJTF) to combat Boko Haram in the Lake Chad region. Saliently, his leadership has been instrumental in strengthening Africa’s diplomatic presence on the global stage by actively promoting strategic partnerships with key international actors.

We are honoured to welcome H.E. Moussa Faki to lead the next phase of the 4P. His mandate will focus on strengthening strategic partnerships, fostering inclusive dialogue, and supporting coordinated efforts to advance a fair and effective transformation of the international financial architecture.
